



What are wood bucks and why should you replace them?

The buck is the wood framing that goes between the actual window and the concrete opening

A wood buck is a critical component in the structural integrity of any Window or Door installation

Impact window frames are **twice** the width of your old windows.

South Florida Building code requires wood bucks to be **as wide** as the new window frames.

Why do the majority of contractors compromise the integrity of the installation by not replacing the wood bucks?

Replacing a wood buck requires extra time, hand skills and equipment. Its costly messy and probably not inspected or enforced by your city's building department yet. Even though the Hurricane Performance and Florida Building Code tested rating for the window is based on the buck being the same or greater than the window frame. When it comes to Retrofit installations the Homeowner is ultimately responsible.

Replace as necessary if rotted or split?

With *High End* installations its **always necessary!**
